The Daytona Beach Symphony Society is celebrating its 60th annual season in 2012 with music, opera and ballet from around the world. Catch performances of Tchaikovsky's *Sleeping Beauty* by the Moscow Festival Ballet and Verdi's *La Traviata* by Teatro Lirico D'Europa at the Peabody Auditorium. The Nordwest Deutsche Philharmonic and the Jacksonville Symphony Orchestra are also on the roster of upcoming highlights.

In addition to the area's beaches, nature lovers will want to be sure to check out the endangered manatees in their natural habitat at Blue Spring State Park.

Start your engines and get in on the fun! Daytona Beach starts getting revved up during Speedweeks in anticipation of the NASCAR Sprint Cup Series Daytona 500 on February 26.

For a quieter scene, stroll along the beach or the Daytona Beach Pier, browse through the galleries at the Harvey W. Lee Jr. Memorial Gallery-Mary McLeod Bethune Fine Arts Center, or take in a bird'seye view of the area from the Ponce de Leon Inlet Lighthouse, the tallest lighthouse in Florida. You may decide to kayak the area's quiet waterways, or bike the trails—maybe even pack a picnic lunch and simply enjoy the calmness of a local park. It's up to you!

EXPERIENCE FLORIDA IN A DIFFERENT WAY

Rent a kayak and hit the water for a day of paddling enjoyment. With a variety of launch sites from which to choose, you may opt to stick to tranquil creeks, estuaries or lakes or take the leap and paddle out into the Atlantic Ocean. Whichever you choose, keep an eye skyward for a glimpse of migrating birds, or, if out in the Atlantic, watch for dolphins

If you'd rather spend your time on land, there's plenty to do there, too, with more than 145 kilometres of biking and hiking trails to challenge varying levels. Cyclists are increasingly visiting Flagler County to explore its off-road trails, paved tracks with Intracoastal views and those through maritime forests. Trail guides are available.

During your stay, be sure to stop by Marineland Dolphin Adventure to meet Flagler County's newest star-Hemingway, a bottlenose dolphin calf. Named after the author himself, who is said to have visited Marineland in the 1940s, Hemingway is the third generation of calves born in the facility.


CALL IT A NIGHT




The shining star of Clearwater most certainly has to be Winter, the dolphin with a prosthetic tail whose life story could recently be seen on the silver screen in *Dolphin Tale*. Now, you can go "behind the scenes" and see where the movie was filmed—and visit Winter herself—at the Clearwater Marine Aquarium. You'll be inspired by her story of perseverance and survival.

Of course, you can't miss the beaches in St. Pete and Clearwater—and all those in between. They are some of the best in the state so you won't want to miss your chance to soak in some rays. As the sun begins to set over the Gulf of Mexico, make your way to Frenchy's on Clearwater Beach (one of the area's few beachfront bars) and toast to another perfect day.
