Avocado groves, art classes, gems and minerals, and bucolic country life

Live Oak County Park

Tucked away in the hills of north San Diego County, the rural enclave of Fallbrook is known as the avocado capital of the world. But the town's other attractions include a thriving art scene, an old-fashioned downtown, and spectacular open spaces.

Explore Tall sycamores and oaks—as well as native plants, such as toyon, elderberry, and sage—dot the serene Los Jilgueros Preserve 1, one of several open spaces under the stewardship of the Fallbrook Land Conservancy. Stroll an easy 1.5-mile trail to take in the beauty of a firescape garden with more than 100 species of drought-tolerant plants. South Mission Road between Pepper Tree Lane and Sterling Bridge. 1-760-728-0889. Pack a picnic, and make your way to Live Oak County Park 2, a scenic 27-acre park with old trees, a creek, trails, playgrounds, and a softball field. Look for grinding holes (6- to 12-inch-wide depressions in grayish brown boulders) that were used by the Luiseño people who once inhabited the area. 2746 Reche Road. 1-760-728-2303.

Learn Be dazzled by tourmaline from San Diego County mines and the fluorescent mineral display at the Fallbrook Gem & Mineral Society museum 3 . 123-B W. Alvarado Street. (760) 728-1130. Reserve a class to paint watercolors, mold clay, or make a print at the Fallbrook School of the Arts 4 . 310 E. Alvarado Street. 1-760-728-6383. The Fallbrook Art Center 5 , a downtown exhibition space, presents rotating sculpture, watercolor, wildlife art, ceramics, and glass shows yearround. 103 S. Main Avenue. 1-760-728-1414.
