

## A Kitchen with a View

A Menlo Park family makes the most of their dramatic view with a sophisticated kitchen redesign.

OR THE SCARGLES, it was a case of not being able to see the forest for the trees. The vexing location of their kitchen counter obscured a wonderful view of their redwood trees and swimming pool. Maximizing a breathtaking view like this is just the kind of challenge Julie Cavanaugh, principal designer and co-owner of Saratoga-based Design 101, relishes.

"Before the renovation," Julie recalls, "the Scargles had a tight, galley-style kitchen. My mission was to create a living space that flowed from the adjacent backyard through the kitchen and into the family room."

Julie's enthusiasm and refined design skills were evident to Jeffrey Scargle, who, along with his wife Phyllis, chose Design 101 from a long list of designers they had interviewed for their Menlo Park horne's kitchen and family room renovation, "We felt that we would enjoy working with Julie and that she had a feel for what we wanted," says Jeffrey. "Their home combines traditional, contemporary, and organic design elements," Julie explains, "and we integrated these elements by using a continuity of materials-such as cabinetry, counters, and flooring-and by injecting splashes of color." Phyllis adds, "The pieces of money plants that are embedded in the laminated opaque-white glass of our backsplash make the kitchen incredibly special. Not only is it beautiful, but it also casts ever-changing shadows on the wall that add to the peaceful feel of the room.


And the fabulous natural bamboo cabinets and black concrete countertops continue that same aesthetic while allowing us to use Green elements in our kitchen."


The Scargles also like how the new, large, elevated kitchen island is strategically placed so visitors in both the family room and the kitchen feel a sense of welcome. Because the Scargles love to entertain, integrating the large quantity of new appliances to create a cohesive look was another priority. "We installed a 48-inch Sub-Zero refrigerator and added a magnetic induction wok, a new product that is very popular now that cooks food very fast while staying cool to the touch,"


